

Driving Instructions

To Ray Hydes sawmill on the Bayfield peninsula in Wisconsin

Instructions

General

- The best route is to take the western leg of Rt 13 through Cornucopia,
- Avoid the eastern Rt 13 route through Washburn because of a significant detour.
- From downtown Duluth its 77 miles and takes about 90 minutes to drive

Specifics

- The saw mill is located at the end of a private road (Lohman Rd) with no street address
- If using a GPS or your phone enter **32500 Old County Highway K, Bayfield County, WI.** (this is the address of Russell Town Hall which is near Ray's mill)
- Coming from the west on highway 13 travel approximately 12 miles past Cornucopia.
- Turn left (North) on W. Old Country Highway K
- go approximately 2 1/2 miles to a private road (Lohman Rd) going South (right side) Watch for a LSW sign that Ray posted
- When you pass the Russell Township Hall on the left Lohman road is just down the hill on the right.
- The sawmill is at the end of Lohman Rd. (when you hear banjos you are near)
